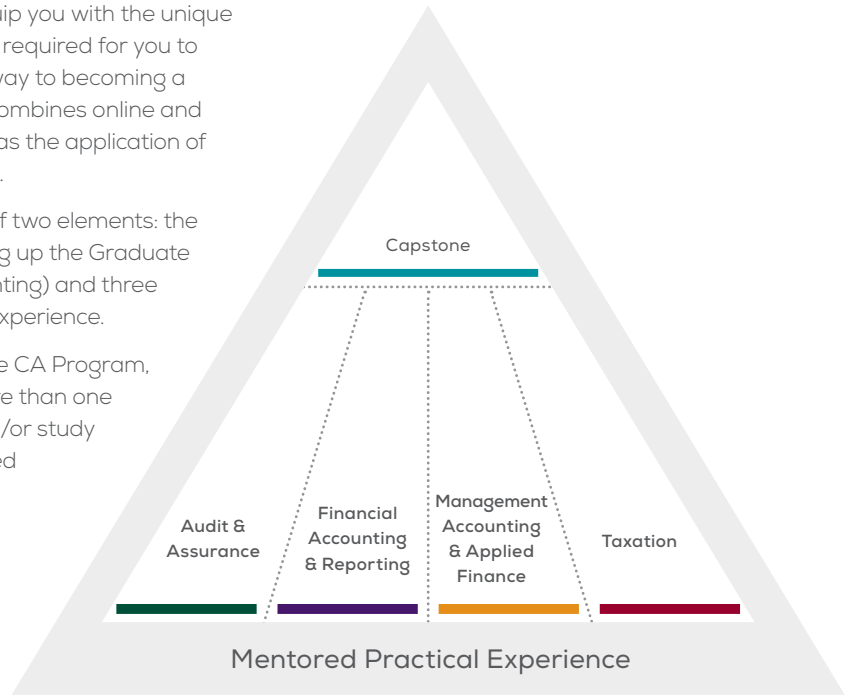

The Chartered Accountants Program

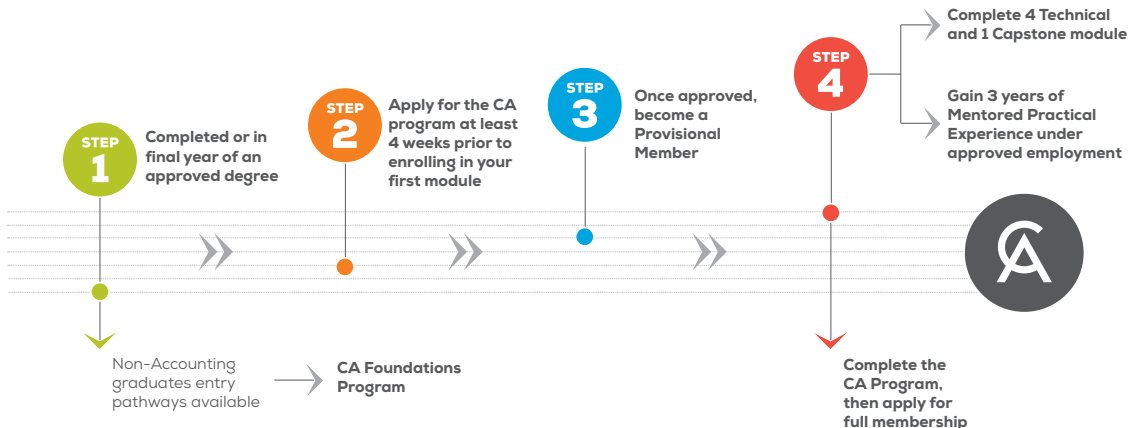
